

Laporan Praktek Kerja Profesi Apoteker di Apotek Atrika Jalan Kartini Raya No. 34A Jakarta Pusat = Report of Pharmacist Internship Program in Atrika Pharmacy Jl. Kartini Raya No. 34A Central Jakarta

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Abstrak

Apotek merupakan sarana kesehatan yang berperan dalam upaya-upaya kesehatan, terutama untuk penyerahan obat dan perbekalan farmasi beserta informasinya kepada masyarakat. Apotek sebagai sarana yang bergerak di bidang jasa pelayanan harus mampu memberikan pelayanan kefarmasian secara tepat dan bermutu. Pelayanan kefarmasian yang dilakukan dalam apotek telah mengalami pergeseran orientasi dari obat ke pasien yang mengacu kepada Pharmaceutical Care. Sebagai konsekuensinya, apoteker dituntut meningkatkan pengetahuan, keterampilan dan perilaku agar dapat melaksanakan interaksi langsung baik kepada pasien maupun kepada tenaga kesehatan lain. Praktek Kerja Profesi Apoteker (PKPA) dilakukan pada 23 September - 1 November 2013 di Apotek Atrika guna memberikan perbekalan bagi para calon apoteker untuk menerapkan ilmu yang telah dipelajari selama masa kuliah secara praktis dan langsung kepada pasien di apotek. Kegiatan PKPA tersebut memberikan pengetahuan langsung mengenai peran, fungsi dan tanggung jawab apoteker dalam pekerjaan kefarmasian di apotek serta memahami dan melaksanakan kegiatan pelayanan kefarmasian di apotek.

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Pharmacy is the health facilities that participate in health efforts, particularly for the delivery of drugs and pharmaceuticals including information to the public. Pharmacies as a means engaged in services must be able to provide appropriate pharmaceutical services and quality. Pharmaceutical services are performed in the pharmacy has shifted the orientation of the drug to patients who refer to Pharmaceutical Care. As a consequence, pharmacists required to increase the knowledge, skills and behaviors in order to carry out a direct interaction both to patients and to other health professionals. Pharmacist Internship Program (PKPA) conducted on September 23rd to November 1st 2013 in the Atrika Pharmacy to provide supplies for prospective pharmacists to apply the knowledge they have learned during the course in a practical and direct to patients in pharmacies. The PKPA activities provide firsthand knowledge about the roles, functions and responsibilities of pharmacists in pharmacy jobs in pharmacy as well as the understanding and implementation of pharmaceutical services at the pharmacy.
