

Persentase operasi caesaria di Indonesia melebihi standar maksimal, apakah sesuai indikasi medis?

Abstrak

Caesarean figure in Indonesia has passed a maximum limit WHO has set. An overview of Caesarean mothers show that 64,52% of whom reside in urban areas with 50,25% received junior high school education and below, and 47,5% are of poor families (quintiles 1 and 2). Approximately 72% of family heads works in informal sector. About 38% of Caesarean surgery were primiparous, where 75% is done where the mothers are not in the high risk age for normal vaginal deliveries. 80% of mothers also do not have history of fetal death and signs of complications during pregnancy only give result of 15,4%.
