

# Sikap Jepang terhadap ajaran katolik dalam kiiroi hito karya Endo Shusaku sebuah kajian narratologis = Japan's reception towards Christianity in Shusaku Endo's *Kiiroi Hito* a study of narratology / Aldrie Alman Drajat

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## Abstrak

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Tesis ini membahas bagaimana sikap Jepang terhadap ajaran Katolik pada Perang Dunia kedua ditampilkan dalam novel *Kiiroi Hito* karya Endo Shusaku. Dengan memanfaatkan analisis struktur naratif dan intertekstual, ditemukan bahwa teks *Kiiroi Hito* menampilkan perbedaan kekristenan Jepang dan Barat. Selain itu diperlihatkan pula kehadiran Endo Shusaku di dalam teks *Kiiroi Hito* yang menjelma sebagai dua tokoh utama yang memiliki spiritualitas yang bertolak belakang. Kajian intertekstualitas menghasilkan temuan bahwa sinkretisasi ajaran Katolik di dalam novel *Kiiroi Hito* dikarenakan kondisi politik pada masa Perang dan hal tersebut relevan dengan fakta sejarah maupun latar belakang Endo Shusaku.
