?Indo? (setengah Indonesia setengah asing). Hal tersebut dikarenakan kebanyakan dari mereka berwajah cantik dan tampan dan secara keseluruhan memiliki bentuk fisik yang menarik. Penggunaan orang Indonesia mixed race tersebut sering kali secara tidak disadari memberi makna bagi konstruksi keindahan fisik tersendiri dalam masyarakat. Film Lost in Love merupakan contoh baik dari bagaimana orang mixed race merepresentasikan bagaimana keindahan fisik ideal di Indonesia itu seharusnya. Film yang bertajuk drama cinta ini dibintangi oleh 3 aktor yang semuanya berketurunan Eropa atau biasa disebut ?Indo?. Pisau analisa utama dalam penelitian ini adalah teori mengenai hiperrealitas dari Jean Baudrillard dan teori mengenai aestetik dari Immanuel Kant.
