Abstrak

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk memperoleh pemahaman mengenai kebijakan pemerintah dalam merespon berbagai permasalahan Tenaga Kerja Indonesia, terutama masalah pelanggaran Hak Asasi Manusia di Arab Saudi sebelum dan setelah moratorium TKI sektor informal. Asumsi lemahnya kebijakan pemerintah Tenaga Kerja Indonesia di Arab Saudi mengakibatkan para Tenaga Kerja Indonesia kurang mendapatkan perlindungan yang seharusnya menjadi hak mereka. Hal tersebut disebabkan adanya masalah institusional terkait Tenaga Kerja Indonesia, masalah prosedur penempatan Tenaga Kerja Indonesia, dan permasalahan di negara tujuan. Hasil penelitian menyarankan untuk membenahi birokrasi, membangun sistem informasi, konsultasi dan sistem penanganan kasus pelanggaran HAM terhadap TKI yang terintegrasi dan dapat diakses publik, serta meningkatkan diplomasi dengan Pemerintah Arab Saudi

.....This research aims to gain an understanding of government policy in responding to the issues of migrant workers. The issue of human rights violations in Saudi Arabia of migrant workers before and after the moratorium informal sector workers especially. The assumption lack of government policy migrant workers in Saudi Arabia resulted in lack of protection that should be their right. Institutional problems related to Indonesian migrant workers, Indonesia migrant workers placement procedures and problems in the destination country are contributing factors to Indonesian migrant workers may lose right in Arab Saudi. The researcher suggests to reorganize the bureaucracy, build information systems of handling cases of human rights violations against migrant workers are integrated and accessible to the public, as well as improve diplomacy with the Government of Saudi Arabia.
