Abstrak

Tesis ini membahas mengenai kesesuaian peraturan pemberlakuan syarat bebas PMK daging dan sapi impor dalam hukum nasional di Indonesia dengan ketentuan dalam Persetujuan SPS, peraturan pemberlakuan syarat bebas PMK daging dan sapi impor yang ideal bagi Indonesia, serta membahas mengenai cara menyikapi ketimpangan suplai dan deman daging dan sapi di Indonesia yang tidak melanggar ketentuan dalam Persetujuan SPS. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode penelitian hukum normatif yang didukung dengan data primer melalui wawancara di Kementerian Pertanian Indonesia sebagai salah satu metode pengumpulan data. Dari hasil penelitian ini menunjukan bahwa pengaturan pemberlakuan syarat bebas PMK daging dan sapi impor dalam hukum nasional di Indonesia secara umum telah sesuai dengan ketentuan-ketentuan dalam Persetujuan SPS walaupun peraturan teknis perlu direvisi agar tercipta harmonisasi regulasi domestik dengan Persetujuan SPS.

.....This thesis discuss about harmonization of regulations on FMD free requirements of import beef and cattle in Indonesia based on SPS Agreement An ideal regulation on FMD free requirements of Import Beef and Cattle For Indonesia as well as discuss about how to overcome the imbalance of supply and demand of beef and cattle in Indonesia that does not violate the provisions in SPS Agreement. This research uses normative methods supported by primary data through interviews in the Ministry of Agriculture of Indonesia as data collection method. The result shows that generally, the regulations on FMD free requirements of import beef and cattle in Indonesia has been harmonized with the provisions of SPS Agreement although the technical regulations still need to be revised in order to create harmonization between domestic regulations and SPS Agreement.
