Abstrak

The treaty establishing a constitution for Europe is supposed to be the end of a long journey of the European Union establishing an integrated Europe, which was started in 1951 with the establishment of the European coal and steel community and recently accomplished with the treaty of Nice in 2001. The constitutional treaty is to supply and the existing, treaties, except for the Euratom. The treaty consists of 44 parts, sub-divided into 448 paragraphs, 36 protocols, 2 annexes and 48 declarations, 852 pages all. It has been signed by 25 heads of states and governments in October 2004. Thirteen member countries have ratified the treaty. The French non and the Dutch no in mid-2005 created a ratification crisis, which resulted in the ratification process being postponed. The European Union decided to "retreat", to open a period of reflection evaluate its future, since those countries which have not yet ratified... will be unable to furnish a clear reply before mid-2007". It will be in the EU agenda for some time to come. A number of proposals to solve the issues have been submitted.
