

# Evakuasi Kaoem Depok Pasca Gedoran Depok, 1945-1946 = The Evacuation of Kaoem Depok community after Gedoran Depok Affairs, 1945-1946

## Abstrak

Penelitian ini berusaha mendeskripsikan proses evakuasi masyarakat Kaoem Depok yang ditahan unsur-unsur bersenjata yang loyal pada Republik Indonesia pasca Gedoran Depok (8-13 Oktober 1945) oleh administrasi militer Sekutu lewat lembaga RAPWI, yang di dalamnya terdapat unsur-unsur militer Inggris-Belanda. Gelombang kekerasan yang melanda Depok pada awal Oktober 1945 disusul oleh penahanan sebagian penduduk Kaoem Depok yang kemudian dibawa ke penjara Pledang di Kota Bogor. Penemuan-penemuan terkait penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa peranan RAPWI selaku Lembaga khusus bentukan Sekutu yang menangani tawanan perang dan Interniran sipil berperan sangat besar dalam seluruh tahapan evakuasi atas penduduk Kaoem Depok yang ditahan di Kota Bogor, dimana lewat kesepakatan-kesepakatan dengan pihak Republik Indonesia, sebagian besar penduduk Depok yang ditawan pihak Republik di Bogor dapat dipindahkan ke kamp-kamp milik Sekutu.

.....This research aims to describe the evacuation process of Kaoem Depok community who were detained by armed elements loyal to the nascent Republic of Indonesia after the Gedoran Depok affairs (8-13 October 1945) by the Allied military administration through the RAPWI institution, which composed by both British and Dutch military elements. The wave of violence that hit Depok in early October 1945 was followed by the arrest of some members of Kaoem Depok communities who were then taken to Pledang prison in Bogor City. The findings related to this research demonstrates the major roles played by RAPWI as the specialised Allied organisation for the management of Allied POWs and civil internees in all stages of the evacuation of the Kaoem Depok members who had been detained in Bogor City, where through agreements with the side of Republic of Indonesia, most of the members of Kaoem Depok which been detained by Republic of Indonesia could be transferred to Allied forces safe-camps.
