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Abstrak

[<b>ABSTRAK</b><br>

Data dari Komisi Penanggulangan AIDS dan Dinas Kesehatan Surakarta menunjukkan bahwa pada tahun 2015 jumlah total kasus HIV/AIDS mencapai 1.356 kasus, dimana terjadi kenaikan sebanyak 172 kasus dari tahun 2013. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui pengalaman ODHA sebagai tenaga volunteer peer group support ODHA. Desain penelitian menggunakan metode kualitatif fenomenologi. Teknik pengambilan sampel dengan purposive sampling. Penelitian ini menggunakan 13 partisipan pada Kelompok Dukungan Sebaya Solo. Hasil penelitian ini menghasilkan 5 (lima). Tema tersebut adalah penilaian positif terhadap diri, sumber motivasi volunteer, tantangan menjadi volunteer, upaya volunteer dalam meningkatkan kualitas hidup dan harapan sebagai volunteer peer group support ODHA. Kesimpulan : Bekerja sebagai volunteer mempengaruhi kehidupan ODHA. Perasaan dihargai, diterima dan bermanfaat bagi sesama dapat meningkatkan kualitas kehidupan ODHA. Diharapkan adanya pemberdayaan terhadap peer support dalam membantu perawatan ODHA.

The theme are self positive value, source of motivation volunteer, volunteer challenges, effort to imcrease quality of life and expectations as volunteer peer group support PLWHA.
